AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMITMENT OF CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 24 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in
- 3 line 31, after the word "hours", the words: —, "unless it is found
- 4 that the child is a damage to himself or others."
