AN ACT PLACING PENSION LIABILITY OUTSIDE THE RESTRICTIONS OF TAX PROPOSITION TWO AND ONE-HALF, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 27C of Chapter 29 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 782 of the Acts of 1981 is hereby further
- 3 amended by adding after Clause (g) the following clause: —
- 4 h. The cost of any pension obligation among the cities and
- 5 towns for its public employees shall not be subject to the
- 6 provisions of this section.
