AN ACT RELATIVE TO FILING REPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end of the last sentence, the
3 following: — In addition, the Commissioner and Assistant
4 Commissioner shall file on a quarterly basis with the joint chairs
5 of the Committee on Commerce and Labor, a list of inspectional
6 districts for industrial, construction, and various other specialized
7 operations. Said list shall include a list of Environmental
8 Engineers and Chemists assigned to the various department
9 inspectional and occupational health operations.
