AN ACT INCREASING THE EXEMPTIONS UNDER THE MASSACHUSETTS ESTATE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 65C of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in section 74 of Chapter 684 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby amended
3 by striking out paragraph (a) and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 (a) There shall be an exemption of six hundred thousand
