By Mr. Kollios of Millbury, petition of Paul Kollios and other members of the House for legislation to provide employment services for persons graduating from high school or turning twenty-two. Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING SERVICES TO THOSE GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL OR TURNING TWENTY—TWO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after Section 12C the following new section: —
- 3 Section 12D. Upon graduation or turning twenty-two, all
- 4 Chapter 688 eligible students shall be provided with the option
- 5 of employment with job supports in an intergrated setting. Those
- 6 students who the transitional advisory committee determines
- 7 require residential services to meet major life needs shall receive
- 8 community based residential services in the least restrictive
- 9 setting.
