AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BULLET PROOF VESTS TO MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 There is hereby established a grant program to be administered
- 2 by the committee on criminal justice within the office of public
- 3 safety for the purpose of providing bullet proof vests to municipal
- 4 police departments for police officers who consent to wear them.
- 5 The committee shall expend such funds as may be appropriated
- 6 therefor.

RESOLUTION

## THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I

Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
