AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PENSIONS FOR COURT OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 66 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "retired", in line 12, the following words: — or any such  
4 court officer of said department who shall have attained the age  
5 of sixty-five, shall be retired,
