By Mr. Kollios of Millbury, petition of Paul Kollios relative to the retirement rights of certain public employees who have attained the age of seventy. Public Service.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE AGE OF SEVENTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 90F of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: — Deductions shall be made from the regular
5 compensation of such member or other person under the
6 provisions of this chapter for such service and it shall be counted
7 as credible service.

1 SECTION 2. Section 90G of said chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the third and fourth sentences and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Deductions shall be made from
5 the regular compensation of such member or other person under
6 the provisions of this chapter and it shall be counted as credible
7 service.

1 SECTION 3. Section ninety G½ of chapter thirty-two of the
2 General Laws is hereby repealed.
