AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF WAGES OF OPERATORS OF RENTED MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 27F of Chapter 149 as most recently
2 amended is hereby further amended by deleting the last sentence
3 in the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: — Said rates of wages shall include payments to health
5 and welfare plans, and pension plans, or, if no such plans are in
6 effect between employers and employees, the amount of such
7 payments shall be paid directly to said operators.

1 SECTION 2. Section 27F of Chapter 149 as most recently
2 amended is hereby further amended by deleting the second
3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following: —
4 Whoever pays less than said rates of wages, including payments
5 to health and welfare funds, pension funds, or the equivalent in
6 wages, on said works, and whoever accepts for his own use, or
7 for the use of any other person, as a rebate, gratuity or in any
8 other guise, any part or portion of said wages or health and welfare
9 funds, or pension funds, shall be punished by a fine of not less
10 than one thousand nor more than five thousand dollars.
