## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPRINKLER SYSTEMS FOR CERTAIN BUILDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 26A½ of Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended in line 11 by inserting after the words "eighty-three A;"  
3 the following words: "provided, further, that sprinklers shall not  
4 be required to be installed in R-2 use group buildings of Type I  
5 construction, where construction has commenced prior to  
6 January first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, as these terms  
7 are defined by the Massachusetts State Building Code, 780 CMR,  
8 Fifth Edition;"
