

HOUSE No. 2710

By Mr. Vellucci of Cambridge, petition of Peter A. Vellucci and Marc D. Draisen relative to safety and emissions inspections for certain motor vehicles. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO SAFETY AND EMISSIONS INSPECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as appearing in
3 the 1990 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: —

5 The registrar shall establish rules and regulations providing for
6 a periodic annual staggered safety and combined safety and
7 emissions inspection of all motor vehicles; provided, however, that
8 motorcycles, motor vehicles more than fifteen model years old
9 before the date of inspection, and motor vehicles not capable of
10 a speed greater than twenty-five miles per hour under any
11 condition of operation or loading on a level surface shall be
12 exempt from such emissions inspection but shall be subject to such
13 safety inspection, and such vehicle shall be inspected for excessive
14 smoke emissions, as provided in section sixteen.
