AN ACT TO REQUIRE MANDATORY RETIREMENT AT AGE 65 FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary,
- 2 all civilians, age sixty-five or older, employed by the state, county,
- 3 or municipal governments in the following departments: police,
- 4 fire, electrical, fire mechanics, and fire alarm operators, shall be
- 5 required to retire.
