AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF PLUMBING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out Section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following new
3 section: —

4 Section 1. "Plumbing", the work and practice, materials and
5 fixtures used in the installation, removal, maintenance, extension,
6 and alteration of a plumbing system; of all piping, fixtures, fixed
7 appliances, and appurtenances in connection with any of the
8 following: Sanitary drainage, storm drainage facilities, special
9 wastes, the venting system and the public or private water-supply
10 system, all piping for the recycling of waste water and/or
11 treatment of water within or adjacent to any building, structure,
12 or conveyance to their connection with any point of public
13 disposal or other acceptable terminal within the property line.
14 Also to include all vacuum, air, and distilled water piping, and
15 piping of gases such as oxygen, Acetylene, Argon, Nitrogen,
16 Helium, Nitric oxide, and/or Nitrous oxide or any other medical
17 gases for hospitals, schools, and medical research laboratories.
