AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws
2 as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out paragraph (b) and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 (b) Any member of Group 1 or Group 2 or Group 4, who is
6 a veteran as defined in section one, shall receive an additional
7 yearly retirement allowance of twenty-five dollars for each year
8 of creditable service or a fraction thereof; provided that the total
9 amount of said additional retirement allowance shall not exceed
10 seven hundred fifty dollars in any case.

11 This act shall only apply to retirements commencing on and
12 after January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
