AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CIVIL SERVICE RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES OF THE DEER ISLAND HOUSE OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all
- 2 employees of the Deer Island House of Correction shall have all
- 3 Chapter 31 rights and benefits restored to those levels held prior
- 4 to July 1, 1991.
