AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL EXEMPTIONS UNDER THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE CONDUCT OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 This would amend paragraph 6 of M.G.L. Chapter 268A
- 2 Section 7 so that it will read: —
- 3 This section shall not prohibit a state employee from teaching
- 4 or providing related educational services, including but not
- 5 limited to coaching, counselling, library assistance, institutional
- 6 research, sponsorship of extracurricular activities and service to
- 7 the educational community, in an educational institution of the
- 8 commonwealth, provided, that such employee does not
- 9 participate in, or have official responsibility for, the financial
- 10 management of such educational institution; and provided,
- 11 further, that such employee is so employed on a part time basis.
- 12 Such employee may be compensated for such services,
- 13 notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty-one of chapter
- 14 thirty.
