AN ACT CONCERNING STATE MANDATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 CHAPTER 29, Section 27C is hereby amended by deleting
2 subsection (d) and inserting the following: —
3 (d) Any city, town or school committee, any committee of the
4 general court, and either house of the general court by a majority
5 vote of its members, may submit written notice to the division
6 of local mandates, established under section six of chapter eleven
7 of the General Laws, requesting that the division determine
8 whether the costs imposed by the commonwealth by any law, rule
9 or regulation subject to the provisions of this section have been
10 paid in full by the commonwealth in the preceding year, and, if
11 not, the amount of any deficiency in such payments. The division
12 shall make public its determination within sixty days after such
13 notice.
