### AN ACT RELATIVE TO COUNTY EXCISE TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 64D of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out in line 33 the word "ninety-two" and inserting in place  
4 thereof the word "ninety-five".

1 SECTION 2. Section 12 of said chapter 64D as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out in line 37 the words "not more  
3 than."

1 SECTION 3. Section 13 of said chapter 64D as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out in line 35 the word "ninety-  
3 one" and inserting in place thereof the word "ninety-five".

1 SECTION 4. Section 11 of chapter 193 of the acts of 1989 is  
2 hereby amended by striking out in the second sentence the word  
3 "ninety-two" and inserting in place thereof the word "ninety-five".

1 SECTION 5. Section 12 of said chapter 193 of the acts of 1989  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the word "ninety-two" and  
3 inserting in place thereof the word "ninety-five".
