AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN PART-TIME RESIDENTS TO VOTE IN LOCAL ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 1F the following section: —
3 Section 1G. a person who is a resident of a city or town, which
4 is not his principal place of residence for a period of sixty days
5 in any year, and is otherwise qualified to vote under the provisions
6 of this chapter may for the purpose of voting in city or town
7 elections and, except insofar as restricted in any town in which
8 a representative town meeting form of government has been
9 established, in any town meeting held for the transaction of town
10 affairs.
