AN ACT REQUIRING PERSONS CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES TO SUBMIT TO AN HTLV-III TEST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 3 section 24C the following section —
- 4 Section 24D. At the time of sentencing, the court may require
- 5 any person convicted of violating the provisions of section twenty-
- 6 two, twenty-two A or twenty-three to submit to a test for the
- 7 presence of the HTLV-III antibody or antigen and the results of
- 8 such test shall be disclosed to the court and the victim of such
- 9 offense.
- 10 The provisions of section seventy F of chapter one hundred
- 11 eleven shall not be applicable to any test ordered hereunder.
