AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPLICATION OF THE BOTTLE BILL, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 321 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 the definition of “Beverage” and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following definition: —
- 5 “Beverages”, soda water or similar soft drinks, mineral water,
- 6 alcoholic beverages as defined in section one of chapter one
- 7 hundred and thirty-eight and fruit jucies but shall not include
- 8 dairy products.
