AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF TRANSIENT VENDORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 101 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 fourth sentence the following sentence: —

4 No license shall be issued under this section until the applicant
5 furnishes proof satisfactory to the issuing authority that he has
6 collected and paid over to the commonwealth all sales taxes
7 required under the provisions of chapter sixty-four H.
