AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE GRANTING OF SPECIAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of Section 14 of chapter 238 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the first sentence the following two sentences: —
4 Such special licenses to sell or consume all alcoholic beverages
5 or wine and malt beverages only as authorized above may when
6 the activity is held on or in property owned by the commonwealth
7 be granted by the local licensing authority. A refusal to grant such
8 license or failure to act upon an application for such license within
9 thirty days may be appealed to the commission under the
10 provisions of section sixty-seven.
