### AN ACT REGARDING RECEIPT AND TRANSMISSION OF BILLS AND VOUCHERS COVERING FEES PAID FOR INDIGENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of Section 27G of Chapter 261  
2 of the General Laws, as amended by Section 154 of chapter 351  
3 of the Acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by striking out the  
4 words "office of the chief administrative justice" and inserting in  
5 place thereof the following words: — committee for public  
6 counsel services.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said Section 27G of  
2 said Chapter 261, as amended by Section 155 of Chapter 351 of  
3 the Acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by striking out the  
4 words "office of the chief administrative justice" and inserting in  
5 place thereof, in each instance, the words: — committee for public  
6 counsel services.

1 SECTION 3. The third paragraph of said section 27G of said  
2 Chapter 261, as amended by Section 156 of Chapter 351 of the  
3 Acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by striking out the words  
4 "office of the chief administrative justice" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the following words: — committee for public counsel.
