

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by the town at its next annual town meeting.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLAINVILLE TO CONSTRUCT, EQUIP AND MAINTAIN A BUILDING FOR USE AS A LIBRARY ON LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PLAINVILLE TOWN PARK, SO CALLED, IN SAID TOWN. Chap. 24

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The town of Plainville is hereby authorized, notwithstanding any limitation contained in chapter forty-five of the General Laws, to build, equip and maintain a building to be used for library purposes only, covering an area of not more than four thousand square feet on the ground, within the limits of Plainville town park, so called, in said town. Said building shall be so located as to interfere as little as possible with the use for recreational or athletic purposes of any part of the park area then so used.

SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by the town at its next annual town meeting.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF THE OFFICE OF REGULAR OR PERMANENT PATROLMAN OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF MEDWAY UNDER CIVIL SERVICE LAWS. Chap. 25

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The office of regular or permanent patrolman of the police department of the town of Medway shall, upon the effective date of this act, become subject to the civil service laws and rules and regulations made thereunder. The tenure of office of any incumbent thereof shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws, but the person holding said office on said effective date shall continue to serve therein only until the expiration of his term of office unless prior thereto he passes a qualifying examination to which he shall be subjected by the division of civil service.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the voters of said town at the annual town meeting in the current year in the form of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting: "Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and forty-seven, entitled 'An Act authorizing the Placing of the Office of Regular or Permanent Patrolman of the Police Department of the Town of Medway under Civil Service Laws', be accepted?" If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, then this act shall thereupon take full effect, but not otherwise. *Approved February 4, 1947.*
