AN ACT REIMBURSING THE TOWNS OF NANTUCKET, OAK BLUFFS, TISBURY AND FALMOUTH CERTAIN EXEMPT REAL PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the  
2 state treasurer shall include on the annual disbursements to the  
3 towns of Nantucket, Oak Bluffs, Tisbury and Falmouth an  
4 amount of money to be drawn from the Highway Fund sufficient  
5 to reimburse said towns for any real estate taxes they would be  
6 entitled to from property of the Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard  
7 and Nantucket Steamship Authority if said property were not  
8 exempt.
