The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE NATIONAL GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The fifth subparagraph of paragraph (b) of
2 Section 15 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by adding at the end of said fifth paragraph the following: —
4 “The clerks and other assistants employed by the adjutant
5 general, including clerical workers, tradesmen, craftsmen,
6 maintenance workers and supervisors, whether salaried or on
7 contract, shall be state employees for the purposes of all statutes
8 dealing with state employees.”

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on passage.
