AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATE PRIMARY AND STATE BIENNIAL ELECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 53, section 28, of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence after the first paragraph: — “All
4 state primary election days preceding biennial state elections shall
5 be designated as legal holidays in the Commonwealth.”

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 54, section 62, of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence: — “All biennial state election days
4 shall be designated as legal holidays in the Commonwealth.”
