1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two  
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of  
3 representatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,  
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study relative to increased state payments to cities and towns  
6 for the costs relative to elections.
