AN ACT RELATIVE TO VAPOR RECOVERY CONTROL SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule, or regulation
2 to the contrary, the Department of Environmental Protection
3 shall promulgate rules and regulations requiring the implemen-
4 tation and use of Stage II Vapor Recovery Control Systems at
5 pumps in which petroleum fuel is dispensed into motor vehicles.
6 Refiner owned motor vehicle dispensing facilities shall install said
7 Vapor Recovery Control Systems on site in accordance with the
8 following schedule:

Gallonge Throughput Per Year	Implementation Date
1,000,000+	4/1/91
500,000 - 999,000	4/1/92
120,000 - 499,999	4/1/93

9 Non-refiner owned motor fuel dispensing facilities shall on
10 April 1, 1993 install said Vapor Recovery Control Systems on site.
11 The requirement for non-refiner owned motor fuel dispensing
12 facilities shall apply to those facilities with an annual gallonge
13 throughput of over 120,000 gallons per year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be in effect until April 2, 1993.
2 Upon that date, the Department of Environmental Protection

3 may promulgate regulations requiring the continued implemen-
4 tation and use of vapor recovery control systems.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
