

HOUSE No. 4592

By Mr. Businger of Brookline, petition of John A. Businger relative to amending the Joint Rules of the General Court concerning the reporting dates for joint committees. Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

1 *Ordered*, That the Joint Rules of the Senate and House of
2 Representatives be amended by striking out the first sentence
3 contained in Joint Rule 10 and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: —

5 “Joint committees and the committees on Rules of the two
6 branches, acting concurrently, shall make final report in the first
7 annual session of the General Court not later than the fourth
8 Wednesday of May on all matters referred to them previously to
9 the fifteenth day of May, and within ten days on all matters
10 referred to them on and after the fifteenth day of May; and in
11 the second annual session of the General Court joint committees
12 and the committees on Rules of the two branches, acting
13 concurrently, shall make final report not later than the fourth
14 Wednesday of April on all matters referred to them previously
15 to the fifteenth day of April, and within ten days on all matters
16 referred to them on and after the fifteenth day of April.”
