

HOUSE No. 4620

By Mr. Moore of Uxbridge, petition of Richard T. Moore for legislation to designate a certain traffic island in the town of Webster as the Anthony D. Dauksz Memorial Square. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE TRAFFIC ISLAND AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 193, THOMPSON ROAD AND EXIT ONE OF INTERSTATE 395 IN THE TOWN OF WEBSTER AS THE ANTHONY DAUKSZ MEMORIAL SQUARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Nothingstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the traffic island located at the intersection of state
3 route 193 (Thompson Road) and Exit One of Interstate 395 in
4 Webster shall be designated as the Anthony Dauksz Memorial
5 Square in recognition of dedication to the town of Webster and
6 the Webster-Dudley Polish-American Veterans.

7 Suitable markers bearing such designation shall be erected
8 thereat by the department of public works, in compliance with
9 the standards of said department.
