

By Mr. Klimm of Barnstable, petition of John C. Klimm relative to the Barnstable Fire District of the town of Barnstable. Local Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BARNSTABLE FIRE DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter one hundred and nine of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six as amended by chapter
3 three hundred and two of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
4 four is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following
5 new sentence: — The District may also operate a golf course until
6 such time as the prudential committee determines such operation
7 is no longer feasible or until such time as the board of water
8 commissioners determines that such golf course is needed for
9 water supply or protection purposes.

1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of chapter one hundred and nine of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-six as amended by chapter
3 three hundred and two of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
4 four is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following
5 new sentence: — No money shall be drawn from the treasury of
6 said district to pay an expense of, or to discharge any liability
7 incurred on account of, its golf course unless and until approved
8 in writing by a majority of the board of golf commissioners
9 hereinafter provided for and authorized by a majority of said
10 prudential committee.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter one hundred and nine of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and twenty-six as amended by chapter three

3 hundred and two of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-four
4 and chapter four hundred ninety-six of the acts of nineteen
5 hundred and seventy-nine is hereby amended by inserting after
6 section five H the following sections: —

7 Section 5I. Upon the approval of this legislation, the
8 prudential committee shall appoint three persons who are
9 residents of the district to constitute a board of golf commission-
10 ers. The initial appointments shall be for one, two and three year
11 terms respectively, but the initial appointment shall run until the
12 date of the second annual district meeting following said
13 appointments. At every annual district meeting subsequent to the
14 above described meeting, one such commissioner shall be
15 appointed for a term of three years. If at any time the prudential
16 committee determines that it is no longer feasible to run a golf
17 course or if at any time the board of water commissioners shall
18 require the land for water purposes and shall so notify the
19 prudential committee, the board of golf commissioners shall be
20 dissolved by the prudential committee.

21 Section 5J. The board of golf commissioners shall oversee the
22 operation of the golf course and shall report at least monthly to
23 the prudential committee. Subject to the approval of the
24 prudential committee, they shall fix membership rates and golf
25 course fees.
