AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2D of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 first paragraph the following paragraph: —

4 The registrar is hereby authorized and empowered to design,
5 issue and regulate the use of temporary registration plates to be
6 issued to non-dealers for use in transporting vehicles purchased
7 at auction or private sales prior to registration. Said plates shall
8 be issued upon application, accompanied by the proper fee and
9 shall be valid for not more than ten days.
