AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATES FOR CERTAIN
VETERANS WITHOUT CHARGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in
3 line 218 after the word "eye" the following: — or disability of one
4 hundred percent and also meet the Medical Advisory Board
5 standards for issuance of handicapped license plates.
