AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A TEMPORARY REDUCTION OF THE SALES TAX ON  
MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter sixty-four H of the  
2 General Laws, for the period beginning July first, nineteen  
3 hundred and ninety-two and ending July first, nineteen hundred  
4 and ninety-two the excise imposed by said chapter sixty-four H  
5 on the sale of new and used motor vehicles shall be at the rate  
6 of two and one-half percent.
