AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CREDIT FOR EMPLOYERS WHO HIRE CERTAIN UNEMPLOYED PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter one hundred and
2 fifty-one A of the General Laws or any other general or special
3 law to the contrary, an employer who hires an individual who is
4 receiving or eligible to receive unemployment benefits pursuant
5 to said chapter one hundred and fifty-one A or whose benefits
6 thereunder have expired shall receive credit in the amount of one
7 and five-tenths percent of the total amount due from such
8 employer under said chapter one hundred and fifty-one A against
9 such liability. Said employer shall receive such credit for a period
10 of two years.
