## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE  
DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATES TO VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after the word "thereof" in line 236, as appearing in  
3 the 1990 Official Edition, the following sentence: — The registrar  
4 may issue, to any veteran, as defined in clause forty-third of  
5 section seven of chapter four, upon presentation of satisfactory  
6 evidence of service in the armed forces of the United States, as  
7 determined by the registrar, distinctive registration plates for one  
8 pleasure passenger vehicle owned and principally used by said  
9 veteran; provided, however, that the registrar shall establish a fee  
10 for said plate as provided in section thirty-three.
