AN ACT RELATIVE TO DIRECTIONAL SIGNS FOR HISTORIAL SITES ON STATE HIGHWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 81 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 22 the following section: —
- 3 Section 22A. The department may erect directional signs for
- 4 historical sites on state highways; provided, however, that no such
- 5 signs shall be erected until sufficient private funds are available
- 6 to pay for such signs; and provided, further, that no funds of the
- 7 commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions shall be
- 8 expended for such signs.
