AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TESTING OF AUDIBLE VEHICLE ALARMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 8A of chapter 129 of the acts of 1991, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
4 paragraph: —

5 No audible vehicle alarm shall be tested within six hundred feet
6 of an occupied building unless such test is conducted inside an
7 enclosed garage which prevents the alarm from being heard within
8 the occupied building.
