## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR PERSONS WHO SERVED ACTIVE DUTY IN THE UNITED STATES MILITARY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 adding the following paragraph: —

4 (r) Any member in service who served active duty in the armed  
5 forces of the United States may, upon filing his application for  
6 retirement, establish full credit for such period of active duty;  
7 provided, however, that such member shall submit to the board  
8 of the system in which he is a member a copy of the form DD-214  
9 showing such period of service; provided, further, that such  
10 member shall pay into the annuity fund of the system in which  
11 he is a member an amount equal to the amount that would have  
12 been deducted from his regular compensation had such active duty  
13 been performed in the period for which he last received regular  
14 compensation immediately preceding the date his retirement  
15 allowance becomes effective; and provided, further, that such  
16 credit shall not be established for a period of service of more than  
17 four years.
