AN ACT RELATIVE TO HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION DATES.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide authorization
3 to schedule high school graduation dates, therefore it is hereby
4 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section four of chapter
2 seventy-one of the General Laws, for the school year commencing
3 in nineteen hundred and ninety-one only, a school committee may
4 schedule the high school graduation more than twelve days prior
5 to the regular closing date of school in order to accommodate
6 certain religious holidays.
