AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE BY CERTAIN PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (e) of subdivision (1) of section 24, of chapter 90 of  
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is  
3 hereby amended by inserting after the penultimate sentence the  
4 following sentence: — In the case of a person under twenty-one  
5 years of age, if such evidence is that such percentage was more  
6 than zero one-hundredths, there shall be a presumption that such  
7 defendant was under the influence of intoxicating liquor.
