AN ACT AUTHORIZING FRANKLIN COUNTY TO ISSUE BONDS OR NOTES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC LOCK RELEASES IN THE FRANKLIN COUNTY JAIL AND HOUSE OF CORRECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sheriff of Franklin County shall install  
2 electric lock release fixtures in the Franklin County Jail and house  
3 of correction in the town of Greenfield. Said sheriff may remodel,  
4 alter or make such improvements to said jail and house of  
5 correction as may be necessary for such installation.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes set forth in section one, the  
2 treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county  
3 commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such  
4 sums as may be necessary, and may issue bonds or notes of the  
5 county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words Franklin  
6 County Jail and House of Correction Loan, Act of 1992.

7 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such  
8 loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their  
9 dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treasurer  
10 and countersigned by a majority of county commissioners. The  
11 county may sell said securities at public or private sale, upon such  
12 terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem

13 proper, but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred  
14 hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter  
15 thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
