AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR CIVIL MOTOR VEHICLE INFRACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (A) of section 3 of chapter 90C of the General Laws,
2 as amended by section 161 of chapter 138 of the acts of 1991, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
4 (7) The registrar and the district court shall collect any
5 scheduled assessment or assessment imposed by a magistrate or
6 justice pursuant to this section within one year from the date of
7 the citation, plus any late fees or other administrative fees
8 provided for by law or regulation and subsequent to such one year
9 period all such assessments and fees shall be forfeited.
