AN ACT TO LICENSE ARBORISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Tree Warden appointment Chapter 41 Section 106 (Section 106
2 to be amended). If the town provides by vote or by bylaw that
3 the tree warden shall be appointed, such appointments shall be
4 made by the selectmen. The person appointed shall exercise the
5 duties of the tree warden and insect pest control. Said person shall
6 be qualified by training and experience in the field of arboriculture,
7 and licensed by the Mass. Pesticide Board in the department of
8 environmental management. The term of the appointment shall
9 be for three years.
