2 sit during the recess of the General Court to make an investigation  
3 and study of House document numbered 4253, relative to the  
4 universal health care law.
- 5     Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk  
9 of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday  
10 in December, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
