By Mr. Clancy of Lynn, petition of Edward J. Clancy, Jr., for legislation to authorize the Lynn Division of the District Court Department of the Trial Court to establish a sick leave bank for Stephen T. Brown, a court officer of said court. The Judiciary.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave
3 bank for a certain employee of the trial court of the
4 commonwealth department, therefore it is hereby declared to be
5 an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of
6 the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial court of the
3 Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to establish a
4 sick leave bank for court officer, Stephen T. Brown of the Lynn
5 District Court of the trial court of the Commonwealth. An
6 employee of the trial court of the Commonwealth may voluntarily
7 contribute one or more of his or her vacation or personal days
8 to said sick leave bank for use by Stephen T. Brown.
