### AN ACT REINSTATING SENIORITY TO DAVID SAN ANTONIO AND TIMOTHY HENRICK IN THE METHUEN POLICE DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter  
2 thirty-one, section thirty-three and other related sections of the  
3 General Laws, the seniority date in the Town of Methuen police  
4 department for David San Antonio shall be established as of May  
5 second, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight and the seniority date  
6 in said department for Timothy Henrick shall be March twenty-  
7 second, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective upon its passage.
