AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSAL OF PAINTS AND PESTICIDES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 52A the following section: —
- 3 Section 52B. Every person or entity which sells paint or
- 4 pesticides shall be required to accept from any individual at no
- 5 charge any remaining or unused paint or pesticide. Every such
- 6 person or entity shall periodically remove or have removed such
- 7 remaining or unused paint or pesticide so as not to violate any
- 8 water pollution control law or any other statute or regulation.
